Also included in this category are cookies for the management of advertising space based on technical criteria such as the edited content, the frequency at which ads are displayed or control of the origin of the potential customer when it has activated an advertising link from a web adhering to affiliate marketing programs.

These cookies are exempt from compliance with the obligations established in Article 22.2 of Law 34/2002 on information society services and electronic commerce - LSSI -.

2. Analysis or measurement Cookies: These are those that, treated by us or third parties, allow us to quantify the number of users and thus perform the measurement and statistical analysis of the use they make of the service offered.
